Schools

\$12.50 per student

- Teachers and classroom aides attend **free**
- Multiple shows may be scheduled per visit
- Programs run **40–45 minutes total**
- Maximum **~40 elementary students** or **~25 older students/adults per show**

Programs for Title I schools may be supported through grant funding when available.

Full-Day School Booking (Most Popular Option)

\$2,400 full-day rate (\$1200 April launch price)

Includes:

- Up to **6 planetarium shows**
- Delivered in one day at the same location
- Setup and takedown included

Best for schools scheduling multiple classes or grade levels.

Libraries, Community Organizations & Youth Groups

\$250 flat rate per show

Ideal for:

- libraries
- scout groups
- YMCAs
- camps
- community centers
- family programs

Multiple shows may be scheduled per visit.

Travel

Programs may include a mileage reimbursement based on round-trip travel using the current IRS mileage rate. Programs within Newtown are travel-free.

Traveling Planetarium — Pricing FAQ

How many people can fit inside the planetarium at once?

Each show accommodates up to ~40 elementary students or ~25 older students/adults.

Why are schools priced per student?

School programs are priced per student to remain consistent with EverWonder's existing outreach structure and to ensure equitable access, regardless of class size.

Pricing: \$12.50 per student, with a 15-student minimum per show

Why is there a full-day school rate?

The full-day option provides predictable budgeting for schools hosting multiple grade levels and allows EverWonder to maximize efficiency.

Full-Day Rate: \$2,400 for up to 6 shows.

Why do libraries receive a flat rate?

Libraries and nonprofit community programs receive a **community access rate** to support free public programming. This rate reflects our mission while still covering staffing, setup, and operational costs.

Library Rate: \$250 flat per show

Why are there different prices for schools and libraries?

EverWonder's pricing reflects how different partners serve their audiences.

Schools typically serve large, scheduled groups, while libraries and community centers offer free public programs with smaller attendance and limited program budgets. Our pricing ensures both accessibility and sustainability.

Why does setup cost the same for small and large groups?

Planetarium setup, equipment, and educator staffing are the same regardless of audience size. Pricing reflects operational effort, not just attendance.

Are discounts offered?

To maintain fairness and program sustainability:

- No volume discounts are applied beyond published tiers.
- Community access pricing is reserved exclusively for libraries and nonprofit public programs.
- Programs for Title I schools may be supported through grant funding *when available*.
